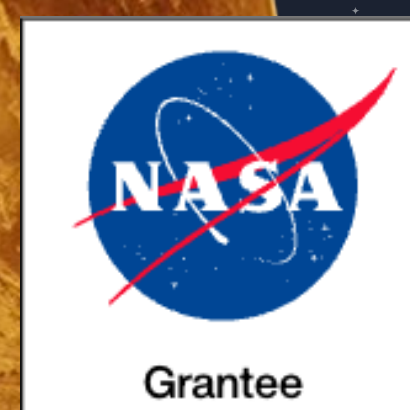

2025-2026 NASA NATIONAL STUDENT CHALLENGE

Challenge applications are open to educators in Arizona, Idaho, Montana, Oregon, Texas, Utah, and Washington who have:

- Mentored a ROADS Challenge team in the past three years, **or**
- Completed the 2025 ROADS from Earth to Venus Professional Development

NESSP's ROADS from Earth to Venus Challenge invites students in grades 3-12 to complete hands-on NASA-inspired STEM activities exploring carbon cycles, atmospheres, remote sensing, and rover data collection.

Teams can submit their results for recognition from NESSP and showcase their work at regional STEM events in April or May 2026.

Application deadline is January 14th, 2026.
